A Summer Reading Program designed to encourage the beginning reader to expand vocabulary, build comprehension, and practice basic reading skills with parental guidance. To encourage children to become familiar with the library and to introduce appropriate books on their reading level, all books must be checked out from the Children's Dept. of the Oil City Library!

RULES:

1. You must read 18 (eighteen) Easy Reader (ER) Books.
(Easy Reader books are located underneath the clock in the Children's Dept.)
2. You must also read 2 (two) Theme Books of your choice.
(see display) 18 + 2 = 20 books TOTAL throughout the program.

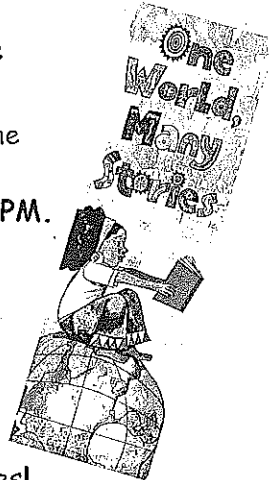


3. After reading aloud each book, have your Parent or Guardian PRINT the Title of the Book & Author's *LAST NAME* on the line as requested along with their *Signature & Date read* on your "One World, Many Stories!" READING LIST. *See example below:*

4. 1 (one) of the Easy Readers (ER) ^{*}Books *must* be read **ALoud** to the Children's Librarian or her Assistant. Please bring your **READING LIST** with you.
*Reading Appointments are a must & may be set up by phoning 678-3072 or visiting the Library. No personal reading sessions will be available without an appointment.
DEADLINE for Reading Appointments is **Friday, August 5, 2011 before 4:00 PM.**



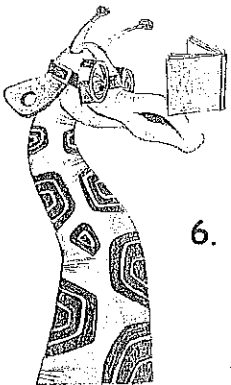
5. Programs will be held *every other* **FRIDAY** morning **10:30**.

DEADLINE is Friday, August 5, 2011 before 4:00 PM.

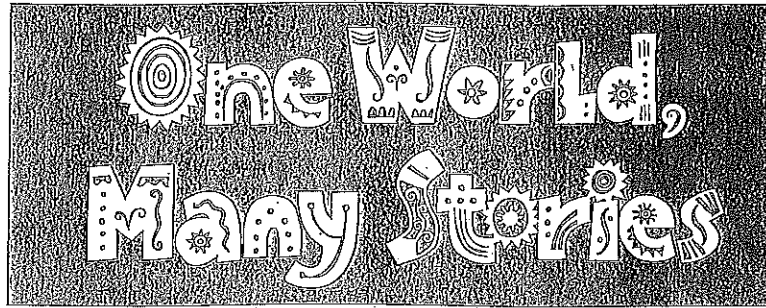
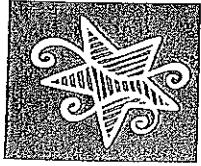

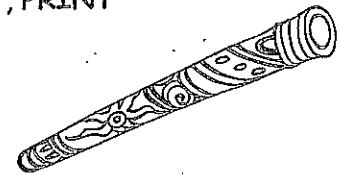
RULES:

(Check out books on display!)



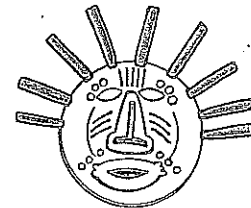
3. Read 1 (one) new 2011 FICTION book on your grade level & complete a BOOK REPORT.
4. After reading each book & completing a BOOK REPORT, PRINT the TITLE & AUTHOR on your READING LIST.

5. Choose & complete 1 (one) ACTIVITY:



A) CREATE: An African Mask, An Australian Didgeridoo, Japanese Origami, etc. or try an International Recipe!
(Many ideas available during programs)

B) ACTIVITY PAGES: word puzzles, mazes, etc.
(Available on request)

DON'T FORGET IT! Your BOOKMARK is also your chance to WIN prizes!

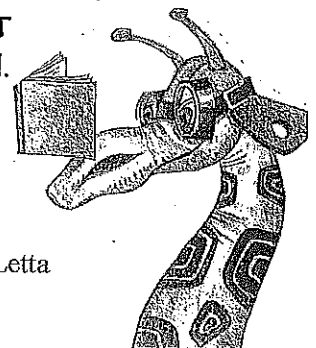
